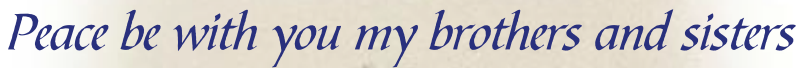
MESSAGE I

I say to you who hear,

*He who finds his life will lose it,
and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.*

Matthew 10:37-39

*Most assuredly, I say to you,
he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door,
but climbs up some other way,
the same is a thief and a robber.*

*But he who enters by the door
is the shepherd of the sheep.
To him the doorkeeper opens,
and the sheep hear his voice;
and he calls his own sheep by name
and leads them out.*

*And when he brings out his own sheep,
he goes before them; and the sheep follow him,
for they know his voice.
Yet they will by no means follow a stranger,

The hireling flees because he is a hireling
and does not care about the sheep.*

and am known by My own.*

And

*As the Father knows Me,
even so I know the Father and I lay
down my life for the sheep.*

*And other sheep I have which are not of this fold;
them also I must bring and they will hear My voice:*

and there will be one flock and one shepherd.

Listen Closely

*My sheep hear My voice,
and I know them, and they follow Me.*

*And I give them eternal life,
and they shall never perish;
neither shall anyone snatch them
out of My hand.*

*My Father, who has given them to Me,
is greater than all;
and no one is able to snatch them
out of My Father's hand.*

*Truly
I say to you who hear,
"I and My Father are One."*

John 10:27-30

*Now,
let these Words sink down in your ears.*

*I am the true vine,
and My Father is the vinedresser.*

*Every branch in Me
that does not bear fruit He takes away;
and every branch that bears fruit
He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.*

Abide in Me, and I in you.

*As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself,
unless it abides in the vine,
neither can you,
unless you abide in Me.*

John 15:1,2,4

Assuredly, I Say to You

Peace be with you.

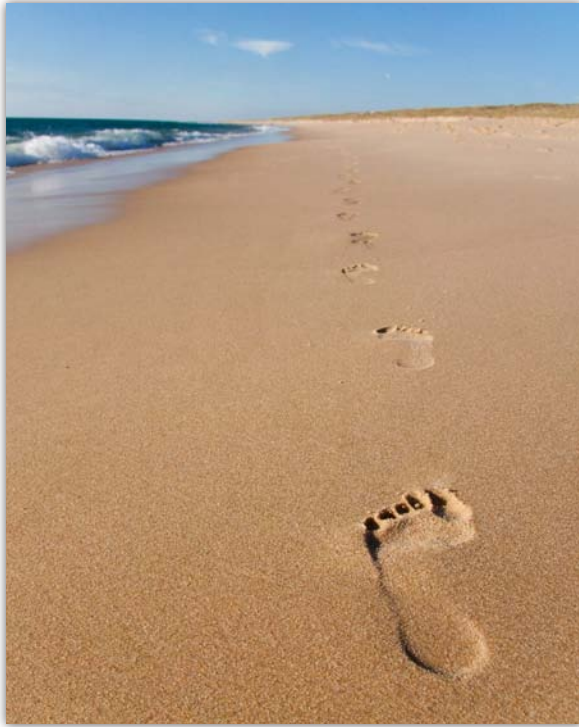

that is, the Son of Man who is in heaven.*

*And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness,
even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,
that whoever believes in Him should
not perish but have eternal life.*

*For God so loved the world that He gave
His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in
Him should not perish but have everlasting life.*

*For God did not send His Son
into the world to condemn the world,
but that the world through Him might be saved.*

John 3:13-17

Assuredly, I Say to You

*He who believes in Him is not condemned;
but he who does not believe is condemned already,
because he has not believed in the name
of the only begotten Son of God.*

*And this is the condemnation,
that the light has come into the world,
and men loved darkness rather than light,
because their deeds were evil.*

*For everyone practicing evil hates the light
and does not come to the light,
lest his deeds should be exposed.*

*“But he who does the truth comes to the
light, that his deeds may be clearly seen,
that they have been done in God.”*

*If anyone desires to come after Me,
let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily,

*For whoever desires to save his life will lose it,
but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.*

*For what profit is it to a man if he
gains the whole world,
and is himself destroyed or lost?*

And

*Whoever is ashamed of Me and My words,
of him the Son of Man will be ashamed
when He comes in His own glory, and in
His Father's, and of the holy angels.*

Luke 9:23-26

And

Whoever confesses Me before men,

*him I will also confess before
My Father who is in heaven.*

But whoever denies Me before men,

*him I will also deny before My Father
who is in heaven.*

Matthew 10:32-33

Assuredly, I Say to You,

*My Father loves Me, because I lay down
My life that I may take it again.*

*No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down
of Myself. I have power to lay it down,
and I have power to take it again. This
command I have received from My Father.*

*He who has My commandments
and keeps them, it is he who loves Me.*

*And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father,
and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.*

John 10:17-18 / 14:21

Now Listen Closely

*As the Father loved Me,
I also have loved you; abide in My love.*

*If you keep My commandments,
you will abide in My love, just as I have
kept My Father's commandments
and abide in His love.*

*These things I have spoken to you,
that My joy may remain in you,
and that your joy may be full.*

And,

*This is my commandment
that you love one another as I have loved you.*

*Greater love has no one than this,
than to lay down one's life for his friends.*

*You are My friends if you do
whatever I command you.*

John 15:9-14

I Tell You Truly,

I am the Bread which came down from heaven.

I am the bread of life.

*I am the Living Bread which came down from heaven.
if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever.*

And

*As the living Father sent Me,
and I live because of the Father,
so he who feeds on Me
will live because of Me.*

John 6:41, 48, 51, 57

Again I say,

*All things
have been delivered to Me by
My Father, and no one knows the Son
except the Father.*

*Nor does anyone know the Father
except the Son, and the one to whom
the Son wills to reveal Him.*

*And, no one can come to Me
unless the Father who sent Me draws him;
and I will raise him up at the last day.*

Matthew 11:27 / John 6:44

*Most assuredly, I say to you,
the Son can do nothing of Himself,
but what He sees the Father do;
for whatever He does,
the Son also does in like manner.*

*For the Father loves the Son,
and shows Him all things
that He Himself does;
and He will show Him greater works
than these, that you may marvel.*

*For as the Father raises the dead
and gives life to them,
even so the Son gives life to
whom He will.*

John 5:19-21

*The Father judges no one,
but has committed all judgment to the Son,
that all should honor the Son
just as they honor the Father.*

Moreover

*He who does not honor the Son
does not honor the Father
who sent Him.*

John 5:22-23

Now Learn This,

*I am the Way,
the Truth, and the Life.*

*No one comes to the Father
except through me.*

*I am the resurrection
and the life.*

*He who believes in Me,
though he may die, he shall live.*

*And whoever lives and believes in Me
shall never die.*

John 14:6 / John 11:25-26

*Most assuredly, I say to you
he who believes in Me,
the works that I do he will do also;
and greater works than these he will do,
because I go to My Father.*

And

*Whatever you ask in My name, that I will do,
that the Father may be glorified in the Son.*

If you ask anything in My name,

I will do it.

John 14:12-14

Assuredly, I Say to You

*All that the Father gives Me will come to Me,
and the one who comes to Me
I will by no means cast out.*

*For I have come down from heaven,
not to do My own will, but the will
of Him who sent Me.*

And

*This is the will of the Father who sent Me,
that of all He has given Me
I should lose nothing,
but should raise it up at the last day.*

*And this is the will of Him who sent Me,
that everyone who sees the Son
and believes in Him may have everlasting life;
and I will raise him up at the last day.*

John 6:37-40

Again I Say

*No one can come to Me unless the Father
who sent Me draws him;
and I will raise him up at the last day.*

*It is written in the prophets,
And they shall all be taught by God.*

*Therefore everyone who has heard
and learned from the Father comes to Me.*

*Not that anyone has seen the Father,
except He who is from God;
He has seen the Father.*

*Most assuredly, I say to you, he who
believes in Me has everlasting life.*

John 6:44-47

Now Listen Closely

*The Father has life in Himself,
so He has granted the Son to have life in
Himself, and has given Him authority to execute
judgment also, because He is the Son of Man.*

*Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming
in which all who are in the graves
will hear His voice and come forth
those who have done good,
to the resurrection of life,
and those who have done evil,
to the resurrection of condemnation.*

*I can of Myself do nothing.
As I hear, I judge;
and My judgment is righteous,
because I do not seek My own will
but the will of the Father who sent Me.*

John 5:26-30

Watch Therefore

*The hour is coming,
and now is,*

*when the true worshipers
will worship the Father
in spirit and truth;*

*for the Father
is seeking such to worship Him.*

*God is Spirit,
and those who worship Him
must worship in spirit and truth.*

John 4:23-24

Peace be with you.

*Then once again **Jesus** started walking and we followed **Him**.*

My Friends, Listen Closely

*It is written, man shall not live by bread alone
but by every word of God.*

Luke 4:4

Hear Me Everyone, and Understand

*If you abide in Me, and My words
abide in you, you will ask what you desire
and it shall be done for you.*

*It is the Spirit who gives life;
the flesh profits nothing. The words that
I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.*

*Most assuredly, I say to you,
he who hears My word and believes
in Him who sent Me has everlasting life,
and shall not come into judgment,
but has passed from death into life.*

And

*The words that I speak to you
I do not speak on My own authority;
but the Father who dwells in Me
does the works.*

John 15:7 / John 6:63 / John 5:24 / John 14:10b

Again I Say

*I have not spoken on My own authority;
but the Father who sent Me
gave Me a command,*

*what I should say
and what I should speak.*

*And I know that
His command is everlasting life.*

*Therefore, whatever I speak,
just as the Father has told Me,
so I speak.*

John 12:49-50

I Tell You Truly

*If anyone loves Me, he will keep
My word; and My Father will love him, and
We will come to him and make Our home with him.*

*He who does not love Me does not keep My words;
and the word which you hear is not Mine
but the Father's who sent Me.*

John 14:23-24

Again I Say

*He who believes in Me,
believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me.
And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me.*

*I have come as a light into the world,
that whoever believes in Me
should not abide in darkness*

*And if anyone hears My words
and does not believe, I do not judge him;
for I did not come to judge the world
but to save the world.*

*He who rejects Me, and does not
receive My words, has that which judges him-
the word that I have spoken
will judge him in the last day.*

John 12:44-48

Now Learn This,

*A good tree does not bear bad fruit,
nor does a bad tree bear good fruit.*

For every tree is known by its own fruit.

*For men do not gather figs from thorns,
nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.*

*A good man out of the good treasure
of his heart brings forth good;*

*and an evil man out of the evil treasure
of his heart brings forth evil.*

*For out of the abundance of the heart
his mouth speaks.*

Luke 6:43-45

Therefore

*Whoever comes to Me, and hears My sayings
and does them,*

*I will show you whom he is like:
He is like a man building a house, who dug deep
and laid the foundation on the rock.*

*And when the flood arose,
the stream beat vehemently against the house,
and could not shake it,
for it was founded on the rock.*

*But he who heard and did nothing
is like a man who built a house on the earth
without a foundation, against which
the stream beat vehemently;
and immediately it fell.
And the ruin of that house was great.*

Luke 6:47-49

Now, let these words sink down in your ears

*Behold, a sower went out to sow.
And as he sowed,
some seed fell by the wayside;
and the birds came and devoured them.*

*Some fell on stony places,
where they did not have much earth;
and they immediately sprang up
because they had no depth of earth.*

*But when the sun was up
they were scorched,
and because they had no root
they withered away.*

*And some fell among thorns,
and the thorns sprang up and choked them.*

*But others fell on good ground
and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold,
some sixty, some thirty.*

He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Matthew 13:3-9

*When anyone hears the word of the kingdom,
and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes
and snatches away what was sown in his heart.
This is he who received seed by the wayside.*

*But he who received the seed
on stony places, this is he who hears the word
and immediately receives it with joy;
yet he has no root in himself, but
endures only for a while.*

*For when tribulation or persecution arises
because of the word, immediately he stumbles.*

*Now he who received seed
among the thorns is he who hears the word,
and the cares of this world
and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word,
and he becomes unfruitful.*

*But he who received seed on the good ground
is he who hears the word and understands it,
who indeed bears fruit and produces:
some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.*

Matthew 13:19-23

I Tell You Truly

*Take heed what you hear.
With the same measure you use,
it will be measured to you;
and to you who hear, more will be given.*

*For every idle word men may speak,
they will give account of it in the day of judgment.*

*For by your words you will be justified,
and by your words you will be condemned.*

Therefore take heed how you hear.

*For whoever has, to him more will be given;
and whoever does not have, even what he
seems to have will be taken from him.*

Then Jesus sat down and we all rested together.



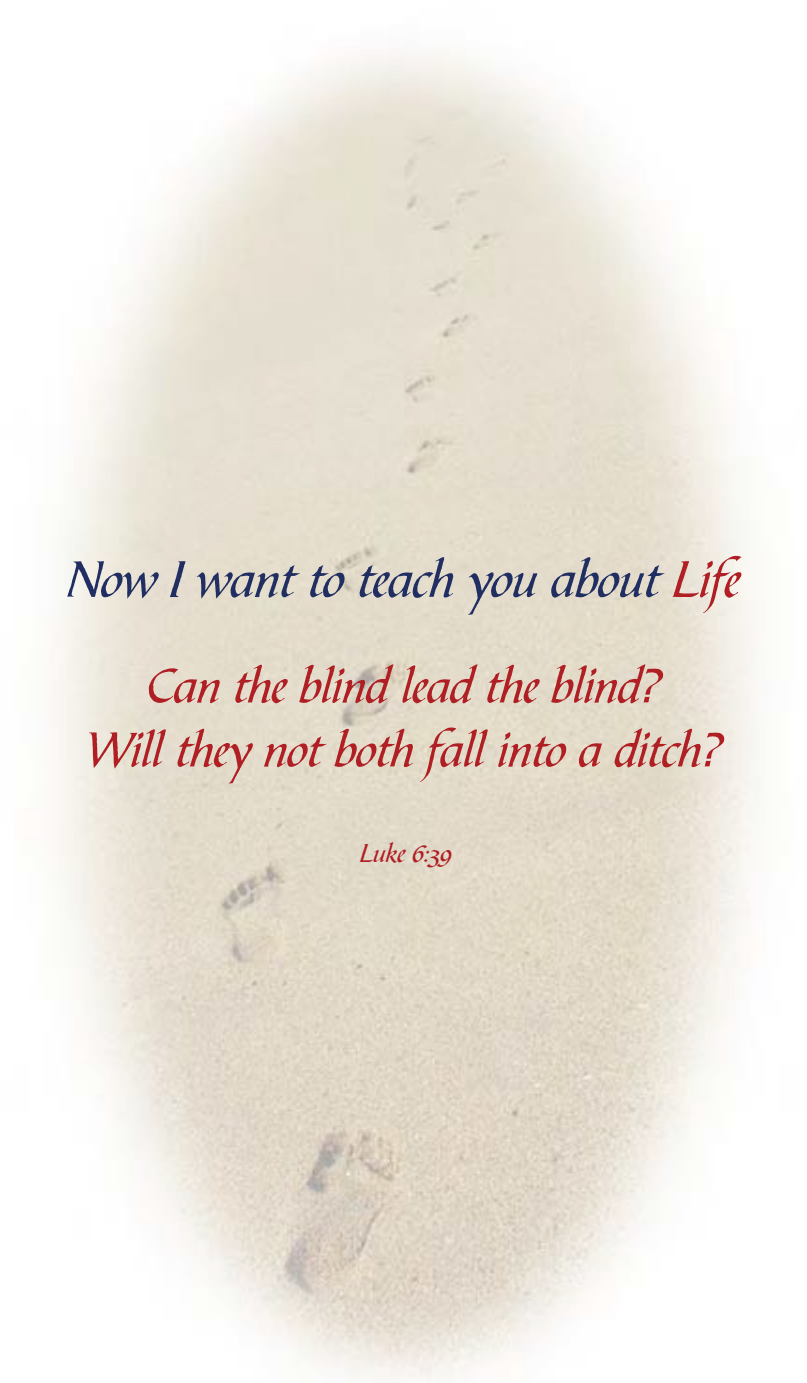

Truly, I Say to You Who Hear

*Enter by the narrow gate;
for wide is the gate and broad is the way
that leads to destruction,
and there are many who go in by it.*

*Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way
which leads to life, and there are few who find it.*

Matthew 7:13-14

Now Listen Closely

*Whoever hears these sayings of Mine,
and does them, I will liken him to a wise man
who built his house on the rock:*

*‘and the rain descended, the floods came,
and the winds blew and beat on that house;
and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.’*

*But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine,
and does not do them, will be like a foolish man
who built his house on the sand:*

*‘and the rain descended, the floods came,
and the winds blew and beat on that house;
and it fell.*

And great was its fall.’

Matthew 7:24-27

*On Love,
I say to you who hear*

*Love the LORD your God
with all your heart, with all your soul,
and..... with all your mind.*

This is the first and great commandment.

*And the second is like it:
You shall love your neighbor
as yourself.*

*On these two commandments
hang all the Law and the Prophets.*

And I tell you truly,

*A new commandment I give to you,

love him and manifest Myself to him.*

Again I say to you

*If you keep My commandments,

And

*Greater love has no one than this,
than to lay down one's life for his friends.*

And

*You are My friends,
if you do whatever I command you.*

John 15:10, 12-14

I say to you who hear:

*Love your enemies,
do good to those who hate you,
bless those who curse you,
and pray for those who spitefully use you.*

*To him who strikes you on the one cheek,
offer the other also. And from him
who takes away your cloak,
do not withhold your tunic either.*

*Give to everyone who asks of you.
And from him who takes away your goods
do not ask them back.
And just as you want men to do to you,
you also do to them likewise.*

Luke 6:27-31

Love your enemies

*If you love those who love you,
what credit is that to you?
For even sinners love those who love them.
and if you do good to those who do good to you,
what credit is that to you?
For even sinners do the same.*

*And if you lend to those from whom you hope
to receive back, what credit is that to you?
For even sinners lend to sinners
to receive as much back.*

*I say to you,
Love your enemies, do good,
and lend, hoping for nothing in return:
and your reward will be great,
and you will be sons of the Most High.*

*For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.
Therefore, be merciful,
just as your Father also is merciful.*

Luke 6:32-36

*You have heard that it was said,
You shall love your neighbor
and hate your enemy.*

*But I say to you, love your enemies,
bless those who curse you,
do good to those who hate you,
and pray for those who spitefully use you
and persecute you,*

*that you may be sons of your Father in heaven;
for He makes His sun rise on the evil
and on the good, and sends rain on the just
and on the unjust.*

*For if you love those who love you,
what reward have you?*

Matthew 5:43-46a

Light

*On Light,
I say to you who hear,*

I am the light of the world.

*Therefore, when your eye is good,
your whole body also is full of light.*

*But when your eye is bad,
your body also is full of darkness.*

*Therefore take heed
that the light which is in you
is not darkness.*

*If then your whole body
is full of light, having no part dark,*

*the whole body will be full of light,
as when the bright shining of a lamp
gives you light.*

*Most assuredly, I say to you,
whatever you ask the Father in
My name He will give you.*

Until now you have asked nothing in My name.

But I tell you truly

*Ask, and you will receive,
that your joy may be full.*

Matthew 7:7-8 / John 16:23,-24

*On Giving,
I say to you who hear,*

*Give,
and it will be given to you:*

*good measure, pressed down,
shaken together, and running over
will be put into your bosom.*

And Remember Always

*With the same measure
that you use,*

*it will be measured
back to you.*

Luke 6:38

*On Charity,
I say to you who hear,*

*Do not do your charitable deeds before men,
to be seen by them.*

*Otherwise you have no reward
from your Father in heaven.*

*Therefore, when you do a charitable deed,
do not sound a trumpet before you

and in the streets,
that they may have glory from men.*

I say to you who hear,*

and when you have shut your door,

In this manner, therefore, pray:

Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

*Your kingdom come. Your will be done.

*And forgive us our debts,
As we forgive our debtors.*

*And do not lead us into temptation,
But deliver us from the evil one.*

*For Yours is the kingdom and the power
and the glory forever.*

Amen.

*On Fasting,
I say to you who hear,*

*do not be like the hypocrites,
with a sad countenance.*

*For they disfigure their faces
that they may appear to men to be fasting.*

Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward.

But you, when you fast,

*anoint your head and wash your face,
so that you do not appear to men to be fasting,

for him if a millstone were hung around his neck,
and he were drowned in the depth of the sea.*

Therefore

*Take heed that you do not despise
one of these little ones, for I say to

*On Swearing,
I say to you who hear,*

*Again you have heard
that it was said to those of old,*

*“You shall not swear falsely, but shall

nor by the earth, for it is His footstool;
or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.*

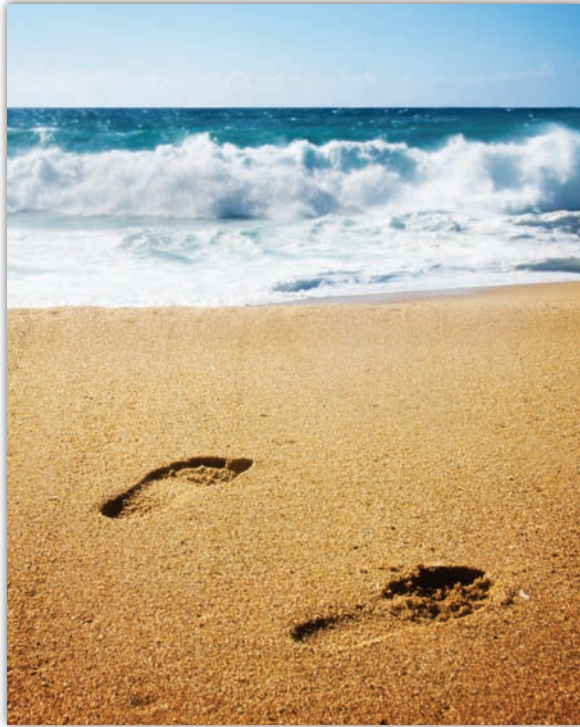

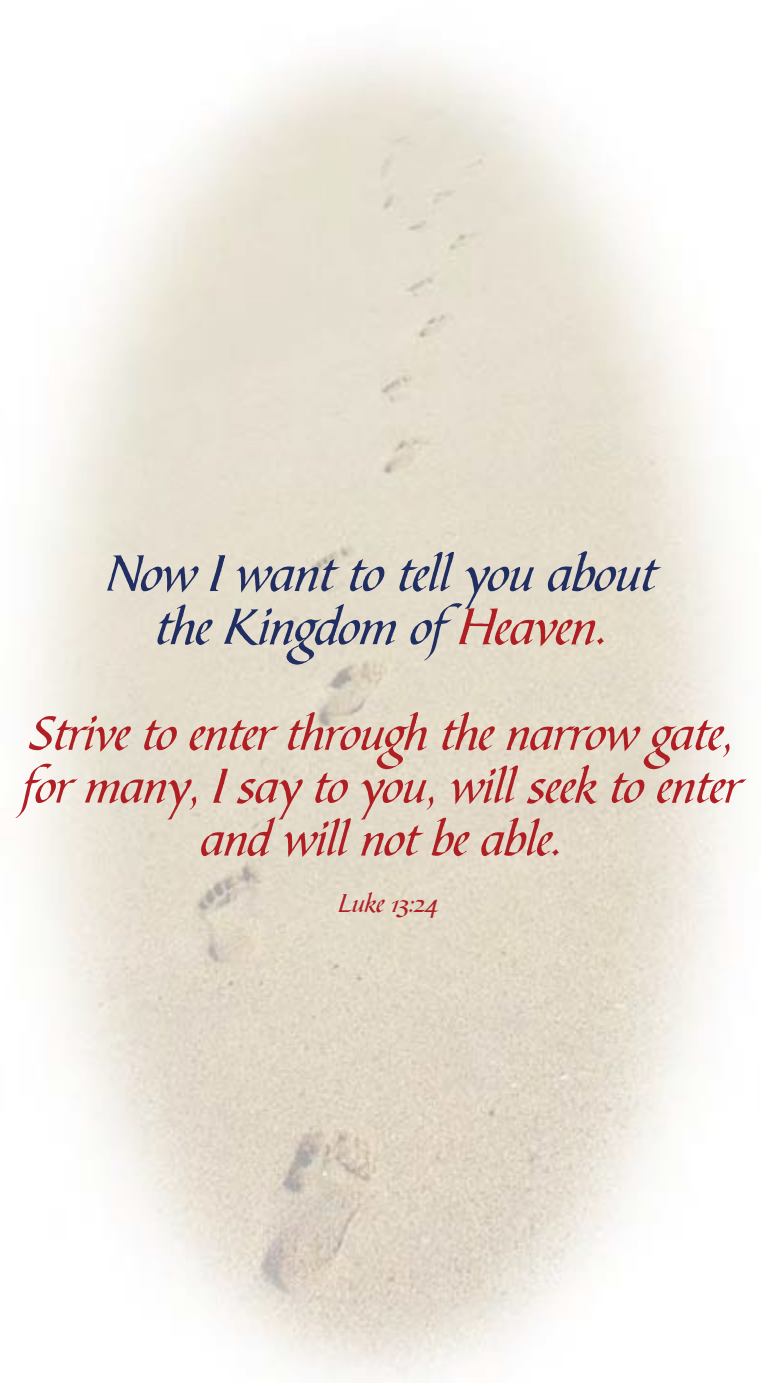

with his wife and children and all that he had,
and that payment be made.*

*The servant therefore fell down before him, saying,
'Master, have patience with me,
and I will pay you all.'*

*Then the master of that servant
was moved with compassion,
released him, and forgave him the debt.*

*But that servant went out
and found one of his fellow servants
who owed him a hundred denarii;
and he laid hands on him
and took him by the throat, saying,*

‘Pay me what you owe!’

*So his fellow servant fell down at his feet

*And he would not,
but went and threw him into prison
till he should pay the debt.*

*So when his fellow servants saw
what had been done, they were very grieved,
and came and told their master
all that had been done.*

*Then his master,
after he had called him, said to him,*

*'You wicked servant!
I forgave you all that debt because you begged me.*

*Should you not also have had compassion
on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?'*

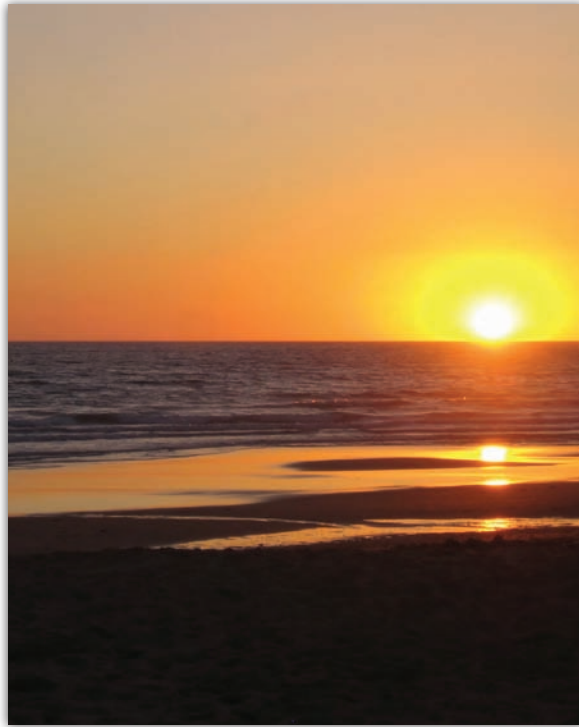

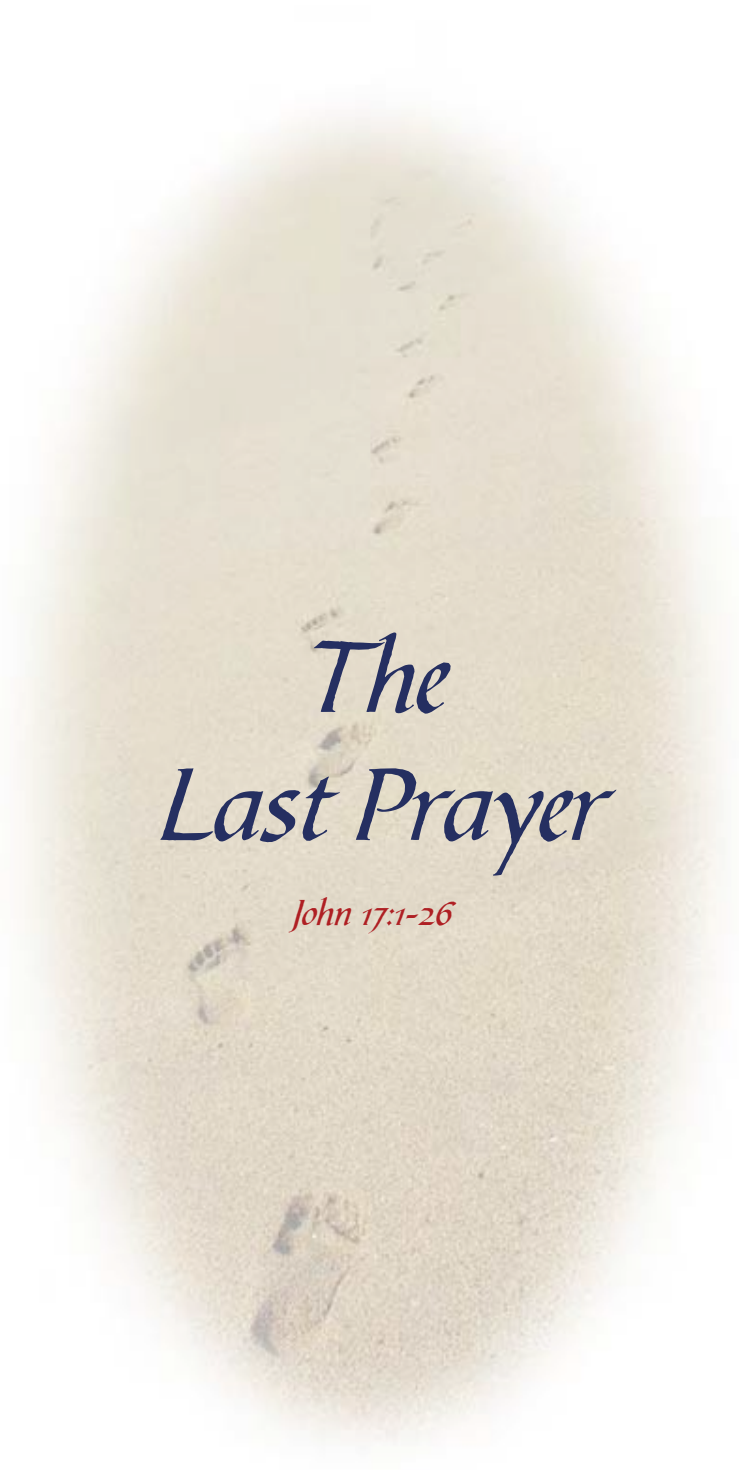

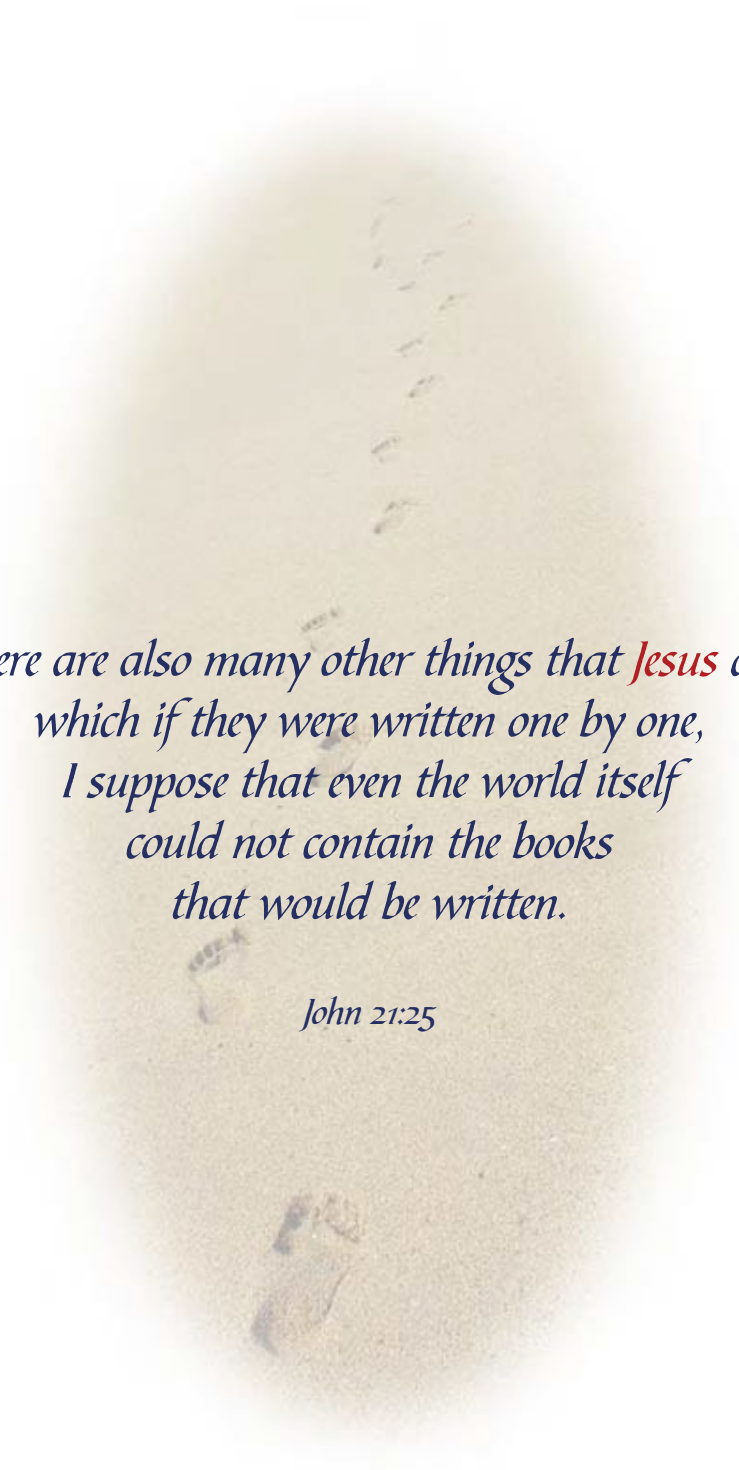

Conclusions in Christ
